The Aboriginal Employment & Participation Manager will be pivotal in influencing the development and implementation of employment policies, strategies and Australian Football programs for young Aboriginal people, while engaging with Aboriginal communities, government agencies, corporate partners and football bodies.

Key responsibilities include:

- Develop and manage Aboriginal employment and participation programs that provide young Aboriginal people with physical, social, educational and vocational skills through Australian Football
- Develop partnerships with government agencies and the corporate sector to increase the SANFL's capacity to deliver programs
- In collaboration with key stakeholders ensure successful delivery of the SAASTA Aboriginal Trainee Partnership program
- Manage, promote and coordinate Aboriginal trainee programs in schools and community organisations
